The program operates from 9 - 3, Monday to Friday.

Our high level of staff support allows us to focus on providing a service that reflects your individual needs and choices, facilitating personal and social development.

The service is specifically tailored to meet the needs of people with an Autism Spectrum Disorder. However, our active, structured and predictable program can be of benefit to many individuals.

Placements in this program may be purchased with individual funding generally negotiated through Disability Services. Transport to and from the program may also be negotiated at a cost.
