



COVID-19 FACE MASKS

Decision-making for clients and visitors

Autism SA is defined as a 'public activity providing disability support services' under current State Directions.

As of 12:01 am on 1 December 2020 the State Government [Emergency Management \(Public Activities No 13\) \(COVID-19\) Direction 2020](#) requires *everyone* on our premises to wear a face mask at all times when they are in the presence of another person. Our premises include our Netley and Elizabeth offices, FSG sites, all residential homes, community places where we deliver services, and spaces that we use to run groups.

There are some exceptions. Our clients with a disability do not need to wear a face mask, but they can if they want to. You can use this decision-making flowchart to help you decide if you should be wearing a face mask.
